

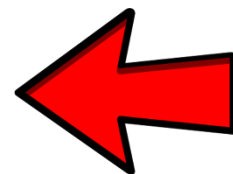
Bald For Bucks Fact Sheet

- ✓ Rampart High School will be conducting its 14th Annual Bald for Bucks on Thursday, May 13, 2021.
- ✓ Bald for Bucks was inspired by Mrs. Sandford, a popular and inspiring teacher, who battled cancer for many years. It was initially started to raise money for her and her family.
- ✓ After Mrs. Sandford passed away, her oldest son brought Bald for Bucks to Rampart High School to support The Colorado Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.
- ✓ Over 1,000 people have participated in Bald for Bucks assemblies.
- ✓ At this assembly, professionally trained stylists shave heads and cut hair to donate so that wigs can be made for children who lose their hair during treatment.
- ✓ This will be the 5th year High Plains Elementary will participate.
- ✓ In March 2020, Rampart High School, Mountain Ridge Middle School, High Plains Elementary, Academy Endeavour Elementary, Academy International Elementary, and Foothills Elementary raised over \$80,000 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society!
- ✓ This total placed the Rampart High School community as #1 in the nation!
- ✓ In 13 years, Bald 4 Bucks has raised \$510,009! That is over
HALF A MILLION DOLLARS!!!!!! 😊
